

## 2025 NEW MEXICO ENCAMPMENT STAFF EQUIPMENT PACKING LIST

These uniform requirements are the MINIMUMS (unless otherwise stated). Please do not attend the encampment without the quantities listed below. **ALL of your items MUST be marked with your last name and first initial in permanent marker.** This list was written with an assumption that staff members have a basic understanding of CAPR 39-1. Staff are only allowed to wear uniforms commensurate with their membership status (cadet or senior member). Senior Members are encouraged, but not required to bring a PT uniform, but all PT uniform elements are mandatory for cadet staff.

**YOU WILL NOT HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO PURCHASE THESE ITEMS AT THE ENCAMPMENT.** Ref: CAPM 39-1 for questions. **SENIOR MEMBER STAFF MEMBERS ARE PERMITTED TO BRING A POCKETKNIFE OR MULTI-TOOL FOR EMERGENCY PURPOSES. ALL OTHER ITEMS CONSIDERED TO BE WEAPONS (FIREARMS, TASERS, PEPPER SPRAY, ETC.) ARE NOT PERMITTED AT ENCAMPMENT. ELECTRONIC HAND-HELD DEVICES ARE PERMITTED FOR SENIOR AND CADET STAFF MEMBERS ONLY. CONTACT THE ENCAMPMENT COMMANDER FOR QUESTIONS ABOUT ITEMS NOT ON THIS LIST.**

**PLEASE DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE WEEK BEFORE ENCAMPMENT TO ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE THE NECESSARY ITEMS.**

\*NOTE 1: Choose a suitcase or duffle bag that you can easily access equipment from. Choose something that you can always keep your property in, but still easily access everything. Padlocks optional.

\*\*NOTE 2: Bring uniforms on the hangers pre-pressed and wrinkle-free. Garment bags for the blues AND utility uniforms. Do not pack your service or utility uniforms in your suitcase. It is required that every staff member bring at least one complete set of a dress uniform (Short sleeve Class B blues or Aviator Shirt Uniform). All staff are required to wear the Class B, short sleeve, uniform on graduation day. Staff members will bring the highest-class level (mess, A, or B) of blues they own. For those who have it, a USAF service coat/mess dress set or corporate blazer (as applicable) will be worn by all Senior Members, Cadet Officers, and Cadet SNCOs. There is no expectation for families to purchase the applicable coat for just this reason.

\*\*\*NOTE 3: If a bladder version of a hydration pack is used by a student (highly recommended) at least 1 extra bladder should be packed. This extra bladder will be used in the event that the original bladder is punctured during encampment activities. Encampment staff will work to take the necessary precautions to ensure that these punctures do not occur or are limited in occurrence.
