

# 2026 NEW MEXICO ENCAMPMENT STUDENT EQUIPMENT PACKING LIST

Use this list to prepare and pack for encampment. These uniform requirements are the **MINIMUMS** (unless otherwise stated). Please do not attend the encampment without the quantities listed below. **ALL of your items MUST be marked with your last name and first initial in permanent marker.** Uniforms and undershirts will be marked on the shirttail. Underpants will be marked on the waistband. Uniform pants will be marked on the product label. **Shoes and Boots must be broken in before encampment.**

**YOU WILL NOT HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO PURCHASE THESE ITEMS AT THE ENCAMPMENT. Ref: CAPR 39-1 for questions. ITEMS NOT ON THIS EQUIPMENT LIST MAY BE CONSIDERED CONTRABAND AND CONFISCATED UPON ARRIVAL AT THE ENCAMPMENT. APPROPRIATE DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS WILL BE TAKEN INCLUDING DISMISSAL FROM ENCAMPMENT IF CONTRABAND IS DISCOVERED. HANDHELD ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE NOT PERMITTED EXCLUDING PRIOR APPROVAL BY THE ENCAMPMENT COMMANDER.**

**PLEASE DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE WEEK BEFORE ENCAMPMENT TO ENSURE THAT YOU HAVE THE NECESSARY ITEMS. PLAN TO ORDER EARLY! YOU WILL NOT HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO PURCHASE UNIFORM ITEMS AT ENCAMPMENT!**

\*NOTE 1: Choose a suitcase or duffle bag that you can easily access equipment from. Choose something that you can always keep your property in, but still easily access everything. Padlocks optional.

\*\*NOTE 2: Bring uniforms on the hangers pre-pressed and wrinkle-free. Garment bags for the blues AND utility uniforms. Do not pack your service or utility uniforms in your suitcase. For both utility and blues uniforms it is preferred for the student to bring two sets of each. However, if uniform availability precludes two sets, the minimum amount is one full set of ABUs and Short Sleeve Class B blues.

\*\*\*NOTE 3: If a bladder version of a hydration pack is used by a student (highly recommended) at least 1 extra bladder should be packed. This extra bladder will be used in the event that the original bladder is punctured during encampment activities. Encampment staff will work to take the necessary precautions to ensure that these punctures do not occur or are limited in occurrence.
